The 145<sup>th</sup> Annual Conclave of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Colorado was held Saturday September 12, 2020. Due to the Covid 19 health crisis, the Convocation was held virtually on a Zoom platform.

#### **OPENING OF GRAND COMMANDERY**

REGC John Zeaphey called on Eminent Sir Knight Randy Penn for a salute to the Flag and to lead the Pledge of Allegiance. Sir Knight Penn then sang the National Anthem and the Canadian National Anthem.

#### **Preliminary Report of the Credentials Committee**

# ADDRESS OF THE RIGHT EMINENT GRAND COMMANDER OF KNIGHTS TEMPLAR OF COLORADO JOHN ZEAPHEY

### GREETINGS

Sir Knights of Colorado, it is my pleasure to share with you some of the activities enjoyed by our Grand Commandery and Sir Knights of Colorado. We started this Templar year with some high expectations. Due to the COVID-19 virus in early March, our plans were massively derailed. Even though we did not have the opportunity to do some things, I thank you all and our Heavenly Father for the opportunity given to me to serve you as Grand Commander. Our 2019 - 2020 Templar year is history. Today we celebrate and start writing a new history chapter. I know we will flourish greatly because of our Leadership team we have in the Grand Commandery Line.

#### VISITATIONS

- It has been my pleasure to visit sixteen Constituent Commanderies in Colorado. On all occasions, my Lady Margie accompanied me with the exception of Georgetown Commandery that was closed to the ladies.
- I was requested by the Grand Commander of Ivanhoe Commandery #11 and Oriental Commandery #18 to forgo our visit to their Commanderies.
- On December 9, 2019, it was my pleasure to attend the joint Christmas Observance Program hosted in Leadville with the Knights of Columbus.
- On March 8, 2020 my Lady & I attended the Alaska Grand York rite Sessions and installed the Sir Knight Richard Brown as their Grand Commander.
- A complete listing of all my Official Visits and other Masonic activities is attached to this report.

### GENERAL ORDERS AND EDICTS

- Grand Encampment <u>General Order No. 11</u> Postponement of the Stated Conclave of a Grand, Subordinate or Constituent Commandery, March 10, 2020 was emailed to all recorders and Commanders.
- <u>Grand Encampment General Order No. 12</u> Prohibition of in-person Conclaves of Grand, Subordinate, and Constituent Commanderies, May 4, 2020 was emailed to all recorders and commanders.

- On April 22, I issued Edict #1, suspending all in person gatherings until further notice, allowing Commanders at their discretion to use on-line platforms for meetings and allowing them to move their annual conclave and elections to any date no later than August 15<sup>t h</sup>.
- I ordered the draping of all Commandery charters for thirty days in honor of Sir Knight Roy Snyder, Grand Recorder of the Grand Commandery of Colorado and Sir Knight Norman L. Hoff, Past Grand Commander of Colorado 1998-1999.

### COMMITTEES

- Most of my committees have functioned well during this year and I thank all of the Sir Knights who accepted the appointment. I would like to thank the Knights Templar Eye Foundation committee for their hard work in promoting the Knights Templar Eye Foundation. I am happy to report that Colorado per capita contribution was \$21.28, resulting in us being 15<sup>t h</sup> in the nation in the Grand Encampment 53 Voluntary Contribution Program, which ran from July 1, 2019 through May 15, 2020.
- I also thank the Public Relations and Patriotic affairs committee for their efforts of arranging for our Sir Knights to participate in the recognition of our great veterans at DIA when they returned from their trips.

- I appointed Sir Knight Ricky Benish to serve as Grand Junior Warden to finish out the term of Sir Knight Bruce Lawlor when he resigned.
- I appointed Sir Knight Matthew Madrid as Grand Prelate when Sir Knight Ricky Benish accepted the appointment as Grand Junior Warden.
- It was my pleasure to appoint Sir Knight Lee Linder as District Inspector for Commanderies (7, 30, 40, 41, and 42).
- It was my pleasure to appoint Sir Knight Brian Flower as the Grand Representative to Arizona.

- It was my pleasure to appoint Sir Knight Tom Dailey as the Grand Representative to Kansas.
- It was my pleasure to appointed Sir Knight Dave Reynolds, Life Memorial Trustee for the Grand Commandery to finish out the term left vacant by Sir Knight Burney Brandel.
- I thank all the Sir Knights for their support and dedication this Templar year.

# DISPENSATION AND BYLAWS CHANGES
