After the submission of our Annual Report for 2018-2019, this committee received information concerning the proposed consolidation of Fremont Chapter No. 14 into Salida Chapter No. 17 pursuant to Section 74 of the Constitution and Laws of the Most Excellent Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Colorado; with the specific stipulation that the consolidated chapters would continue to operate under the existing charter of Salida Chapter No. 17.

Published in the preprinted reports for the current Grand Chapter is a copy of a detailed notice provided to the members of Salida Chapter No. 17. After noting that the date of said letter should be corrected to read "February 4, 2019," the letter was incorporated into this report by reference.

Saturday, October 5th in Winslow, Arizona.

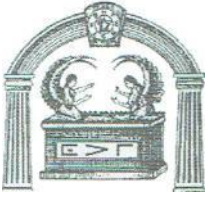
