## The Grand Sovereign



**Knight Companion**  
**Erwin W. O'Dell, KGC**

Erwin Wesley O'Dell was born in Hazel Park, Michigan on February 8, 1936 to Hazel I. and Marvin J. O'Dell. Erwin was raised in the Columbiaville, Michigan and graduated from Columbiaville High School in 1954. Upon graduation from High School Erwin joined the United States Coast Guard and served a total of eight years, four years of active duty and four years in the inactive reserves. While stationed in New York and living in Staten Island in 1957 Erwin petitioned Masonry and was accepted in the Lodge Of United

Services No. 1118 a military lodge, located at 71 West 23 Street in New York, New York.

Erwin is married to Susan Lynn (Parrott) O'Dell and they have four grown children and ten grandchildren. The O'Dell's were members of Trinity Episcopal Church in Marshall. Erwin served as a licensed Lay reader and Chalice bearer for over twenty years. Susan served as many years on the Altar Guild. Dr. O'Dell has been a member of the Marshall area Chamber of Commerce and in his field of practice he served as District II President for two years.

Brother O'Dell left active duty with the U.S. Coast Guard in the spring of 1958 and in September of that year enrolled in Palmer College of Chiropractic. He completed his four academic years of college in the fall of 1961, graduating with a Doctor of Chiropractic degree. While at Palmer College Erwin served as President of the Michigan Club, President of the Trowel Club (the Masonic Club), Vice President of the Student Activities Committee, Vice President of the Student Council and was a member of the Delta Sigma Chi a National Chiropractic Fraternity. After postgraduate studies in Minneapolis, Minnesota and Long Island, New York, Erwin located his office in Delhi, New York in the spring of 1962 and practiced in that community for two and a half years. He relocated his office to Marshall, Michigan in the fall of 1964.

Dr. O'Dell practiced forty-six years as a Chiropractor with forty-one years in Marshall, Michigan. He attained the status of Qualified Chiropractic Orthopedist, was a Board Certified Fellow of ASBE and holds membership in the American Chiropractic Association and the Michigan State Chiropractic Association. He is an Advance Proficiency level as an Activator Method

Chiropractic Practitioner. He retired from active practice in 2005, however he continues to keep his certification current and retains his Michigan license.

In 1967 Erwin moved his Lodge membership to St. Albans Lodge No. 20, F.&A.M. in Marshall. He immediately became active in the Marshall Masonic bodies, becoming a member of Lafayette Chapter No. 4, RAM; Marshall Commandery No. 17, Knights Templar; and Albion Council No. 57, Royal and Select Masters located at Albion, Michigan. Brother O'Dell was a member of the Order of Eastern Star and continues his membership in the White Shrine of Jerusalem.

In 1971, Brother O'Dell served as Commander of Marshall Commandery No. 17, High Priest of Lafayette Chapter No. 4 and Thrice Illustrious Master of Albion Council No. 57. In 1974 Erwin served as Master of St. Albans Lodge No.20. He has served as Commander on two other occasions; High Priest of the Chapter three times; Thrice Illustrious Master of the Council twice and Master of the lodge on two more occasions. In 1978 Sir Knight O'Dell was elected as Grand Junior Warden of the Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Michigan and presided as Grand Commander in 1983.

Erwin petitioned the Valley of Grand Rapids Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite in 1976 and was elected President of the Fred England, Jr. Class. He became active in the 25<sup>th</sup> degree and later served as Director of that degree for several years. In 1983 he was elected to the first of two elected terms on the Board of Trustees of the Valley of Grand Rapids. During the years on that board Erwin was twice elected Vice President.

In Cincinnati Ohio in September of 1986 Dr. O'Dell was elected to receive the 33<sup>rd</sup> degree at Supreme Council in 1987 in Boston, Massachusetts. In May of 1987 Erwin was elected as 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt. Commander of DeWitt Clinton Consistory and in September of that year was Coroneted a 33<sup>rd</sup> degree. In May of 1991 Erwin was elected Commander-in-Chief of the Consistory and President of the board of trustees. In September of 1991 at Indianapolis, Indiana, Erwin was elected as an Active Member of the Supreme Council and in 2002 was elected as the 14<sup>th</sup> Deputy for the Division of Michigan. In August of 2009 Knight Companion O'Dell resigned as

Deputy for Michigan and was granted Active Emeritus status as a member of the NMJ.

Other memberships Dr. O'Dell holds include the Royal Order of Scotland; KYCH; York Rite College, PG and holder of the Purple Cross; AMD, PSM including Red Branch of Erie, Masonic Order of the Bath, and Grand College of Rites; Sword of Bunker Hill; HRAKTP and PP; and holds the IX<sup>o</sup> is the SRICF. Brother O'Dell has received the Order of Silver Trowel, the Order of High Priesthood, the Order of Scarlet Cord and the Honorary Legion of Honor from DeMolay. He is a member of C.B.C.S., a life member of Saladin Shrine of Grand Rapids, Michigan and a former member of the Tall Cedars of Lebanon. He was selected as the Mason of the Year for St. Albans Lodge in 1988. He holds honorary memberships in numerous Commanderies, Masonic Lodges and Conclaves of the Red Cross of Constantine in Michigan. His non-Masonic memberships over the years have included the Kiwanis Club of Delhi, New York, the Exchange Club of Marshall and Marshall Moose Lodge. He was a member of the Marshall Area Chamber of Commerce for several years.

Knight Companion O'Dell was invited into membership in St. Vincent Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine at Grand Rapids, Michigan in 1983. He is a Past Sovereign and Former Intendant General for Michigan. In June of 2004 at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, KC O'Dell was elected as Grand Almoner of the United Grand Imperial Council of the Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine. On June 13, 2009 he was elected and installed as the Grand Sovereign of the Red Cross of Constantine for the United States of America, Mexico and the Philippines. On the occasion of his installation as Grand Sovereign, he was elevated to the rank of KGC.

It has been fifty-five years since a Knight Companion from Michigan, Joseph William Kane, KGC, presided over the United Grand Imperial Council and eighty-three years since a member of St. Vincent Conclave, William G. Bray, KGC, held that office. Michigan looks forward to hosting the Grand Assembly in Troy, Michigan in June of 2010.

# The 137<sup>th</sup> Annual Assembly

The 137<sup>th</sup> Annual Assembly of the United Grand Imperial Council of the Red Cross of Constantine was held in Oklahoma City 11-13 June 2009. It was very well organized and a highly successful event. The breakdown of the attendance is as follows:

## Legislative Actions

There were two legislative actions taken at the June 11-13, 2009 Annual Assembly of the United Grand Imperial Council of the Red Cross of Constantine held in Oklahoma City.

The first item was a reduction of the regular membership limits for Conclaves. The reduction was as follows: -- for Conclaves with a membership limit of 50 or less, a ten percent (10%) reduction, with the number which results, if not a multiple of five, rounded up to the next higher multiple of five. Thus, if a Conclave had a membership limit of 40, ten percent of 40 is 4 and 40 minus 4 equals 36, which, rounded up to the next multiple of five yields 40 . . . so such a Conclave was not affected by the legislation. This example holds true for all Conclaves which had a regular membership limit less than fifty and which membership limit was an even multiple of five. There are three Conclaves (City of Mexico, San Juan (Puerto Rico) and Mountain State (WV) which had a membership limit of 33 and applying the formula above results in a new membership limit of 30. Also, for a Conclave which had a membership limit of 50, applying the above formula yields 50 minus 10% (5) yields 45 which, being a multiple of five, results in a new membership limit of 45.

--for Conclaves which had a membership limit greater than fifty, the reduction was twenty percent (20%) with the same procedure laid out above being followed. Thus a Conclave which had a membership limit of 100 now has a membership limit of 80 and a Conclave which had a membership limit of 75 now has a membership limit of 60. I believe we have about 18 Conclaves which had a membership limit greater than 80.

The second legislative action was to restrict each Conclave's exclusive jurisdiction to the County in which it is located. This is specified in our Constitution, Statutes and Regulations (General Statutes, Section 7(a), page 51) but over the years several Conclaves had expanded their exclusive jurisdiction, or were, perhaps, originally chartered with an exclusive jurisdiction greater than the County in which they are stationed.

Both of the above actions are effectively modifications to the by-laws of those Conclaves which are affected by them. Individual Conclaves do not need file by-laws changes to reflect the above. The changes were made by the United Grand Imperial Council.
