This form should be prepared immediately after presenting a recruitment program at a Lodge or any other assembly of Masons. It is permissible to present a program at an assembly of non-masons such as a bring a friend night. The presenter should take precautions to assure he remains within Grand Lodge guidelines.

A presenter can only provide a presentation for ONE body of the York Rite. If three members of a York Rite Body go to a location and give a presentation, one of the three can receive credit for a Chapter, one for a Council, and one for a Commandery presentation.

Petitions for the York Rite Degrees and Orders are essential in the presentation. They can be printed out from many websites.

Once completed, these forms should be mailed to the Grand Secretary/Recorder no later than December 31, of the calendar year. He will send the forms to the Chair of the Grand Membership Committee of the pertinent Grand Body. The Chair of the pertinent Grand Membership Committee will present the award to the presiding officer present of the Chapter, Council, and Commandery having performed the most presentations during the calendar year.

This award will be held by the Chapter, Council, and Commandery for a year and returned to the Grand Session for presentation the next year.
